Purpose: Overall oversight and management of the organization; acts as the official representative of ABM. Length of term: 6 total years on board:	 Lead board and executive committee meetings and set agendas in collaboration with the executive director. Participates in collaboration with officers and directors of the board in the general oversight of the affairs of ABM. Appoints task force and committee chairs. Assign board liaisons to task forces, committees, and external organizations. Represents ABM in the breastfeeding medicine community. Leads annual membership meeting. Writes a column for <i>Breastfeeding Medicine</i>. Votes on all policies affecting membership. Uphold the organization's precepts, mission, and goals and abide by the conflict-of-interest guidelines. Provides mentorship and recognition. 	 Must be a Physician-level member in Category 1, 2, 3, or a Gold member. Continuous member of ABM for the last five years. Must have served in a previous position on the ABM board of directors within the past five years. Demonstrated experience volunteering within a global, national, or local organization as a board member, committee chair, project leader, or local chapter leader. History of consistent meeting attendance and successful work outcomes at meetings applicable to previous organizational leadership roles. Recommendation from an ABM member in a current or previous leadership position. Ability to disrupt "group think" Innovative thinker with the ability to focus on strategy. Adaptable to changing environment Strong collaboration/relationship-building skills. Understanding or ability to understand the complexity of the Academy. Commitment of time required to serve in the position from the candidate's institution(s).
